Compliance Report on the fulfillment of the conditions imposed by the Local Inquiry Committee in respect of the college should be submitted within 15 days failing which the application for renewal of affiliation for the succeeding academic year will not be entertained.

## Conditions:

1. The conditions imposed by the Local Inquiry Committee shall be complied with strictly.
2. Government order no: ED: 29 UNE 2021, dt: 12-02-2021, notification within next two years colleges must meet all eight defined parameters listed in the Local Inquiry Committee report.
3. Admission to the integrated courses as directed by the government shall be done compulsorily through the government UUCMS portal.
4. University will not approve such as the admissions made in excess of the prescribed intake.
5. The sections shall not be increased in respect of any course of study without the prior approval of the university.
6. While making admissions of students to the said UG courses the orders of the government issued from time to time regulating the reservation shall be strictly followed.
7. As far as open electives are concerned, the intake of each subject in the total approved courses combinations of each affiliated college should not exceed $50 \%$ of the current approved intakes.
8. The rules \& regulations and also the orders of the university published from time to time in respect of students of the college, faculty \& non-teaching staff shall be enforced. The college shall not exceed the maximum of the intake prescribed in the affiliation notification $\&$ shall not violate the maximum eligibility criteria prescribed for admission of students of each course.
9. In respect of PG courses without exceeding the intake and other fees as prescribed from time to time admission of such students sponsored by the university to the extent of $50 \%$ of the intake ( $100 \%$ in case of government colleges) shall be made.
10. As held by the supreme court in its judgment dated 13.08.1997 in Viashakh v/s Rajasthan State government, in colleges or offices or any other work spot, any person / student creates disturbance or any person (teaching/ non 1fay

harassment in any manner is considered as an punishable offence. If any person / student having been indulged or participated in such activities shall be liable for expulsion from his employment or studentship. Therefore the college shall in compliance with the ruling of the Supreme Court shall constitute the grievances committee for curbing such offences/ activities \& initiate all the regulatory measures in this regard.
11. The college shall improve the standard of education to the extent of the academic development of the students in respect of each course \& management shall adopt a sympathetic approach towards the students, in service teachers \& Principal.
12. The marks list \& other academic documents submitted by the students for admission approval shall be promptly distributed to the students after admission approval \& a report thereof submitted to university.
13. The marks sheets, degree certificate \& other academic documents of the college students should be returned to the students within three months. The Registrar (Evaluation) shall report to the chancellor (Evaluation) about the marks sheets and degree certificate retained by them after the expiry of the period.
14. If requisition is submitted by the students for Transfer certificate it shall be issued without causing any hardship to the students. It is impermissible to collect any fee in excess of the annual tuition fee / semester tuition fee prescribed by the rules.
15. The college shall not charge any kind of capitation fee.
16. Kannada should be used in the administration compulsorily.
17. The college shall submit the application for Renewal of Affiliation of the courses for the academic year 2023-24 without fail.
18. Colleges which are completed 5 years will have to obtain NAAC accreditation immediately.
19. Principals will have to submit the list of eligible faculty members for the purpose of valuation to the board of examiners without fail. Failing which affiliation of the college will be withdrawn.
Note: BU Notification No:ACA-3/A3/SN/PIMS/2022-23, dt: 26-07-2022 by M.COM, an order has already been issued to increase the students intake from 30 to 50 .

In exercise of the power conferred by section 59 (11) of the Karnataka State Universities act 2000 and the University regulations the Bangalore University has sanctioned new courses in Padmashree Institute of Management and Sciences, Bangalore from the academic year 2022-23 subject to the following conditions:

1. Notwithstanding any provision contained in the Grant in aid code applicable to the colleges grants will not be sanctioned at any time to the above courses. They will be considered as permanently unaided courses.
2. The rules and orders of the Government issued from time to time shall be strictly implemented.
3. Admission to the integrated courses as directed by the government shall be done compulsorily through the government UUCMS portal.
4. The sections shall not be increased in respect of any course of study without the prior approval of the university.
5. As far as open electives are concerned, the intake of each subject in the total approved courses combinations of each affiliated college should not exceed $50 \%$ of the current approved intakes.
6. The conditions imposed by the Local Inquiry Committee shall be complied with strictly.
7. While making admissions of students to the said courses the orders of the government issued from time to time regulating the reservation shall be strictly followed.

8. Admission to master's degree courses shall be made from university sponsored students to the extent of $50 \%$ of the prescribed student strength, subject to the admission and such fees as may be prescribed by the university from time to time.
9. The rules \& regulations and also the orders of the university published from time to time in respect of students of the college, faculty \& non-teaching staff shall be enforced. The college shall not exceed the maximum of the intake prescribed in the affiliation notification \& shall not violate the maximum eligibility criteria prescribed for admission of students of each course. If admissions of students are made in excess of the intake the affiliation will be cancelled
10. The College / Management shall set apart the $50 \%$ of university quota (wherever it is applicable) in terms of the University regulations: Shall charge the fee structure prescribed by the University from time to time and shall not collect over and above the Fees / Amount stipulated by the University.
11. The college shall improve the standard of education to the extent of the academic development of the students in respect of each course \& management shall adopt a sympathetic approach towards the students, in service teachers \& Principal.
12. As held by the supreme court in its judgment dated 13.08 .1997 in Viashakh v/s Rajasthan State government, in colleges or offices or any other work spot, any person / student creates disturbance or any person (teaching/ non- teaching/ management) or any students causing any harassment or sexual harassment in any manner is considered as an punishable offence. If any person / student having been indulged or participated in such activities shall be liable for expulsion from his employment or studentship. Therefore the college shall in compliance with the ruling of the Supreme Court shall constitute the grievances committee for curbing such offences/ activities \& initiate all the regulatory measures in this regard.
13. The college shall not hold over the marks cards \& other academic documents on invalid grounds beyond six months. The original marks cards \& other academic documents submitted for the approval of admissions shall be returned respectively to the concerned students expeditiously after their approval of admissions \& a report thereof submitted to university.
14. If requisition is submitted by the students for Transfer certificate it shall be issued without causing any hardship to the students. It is impermissible to collect any fee in excess of the annual tuition fee / semester tuition fee prescribed by the rules.
15. The college shall not charge any kind of capitation fee.

17. Kannada should be used in the administration compulsorily.
