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


Program Summary

This outreach program was supported by DST, New Delhi and organised by PIMS in collaboration with village panchayath. The waste was utilized to prepare feed for poultry and fish. The presentation was made in local language Kannada and explained the process of make the feed stepwise and the composition of addition of ingredients in right proportion was emphasized. 
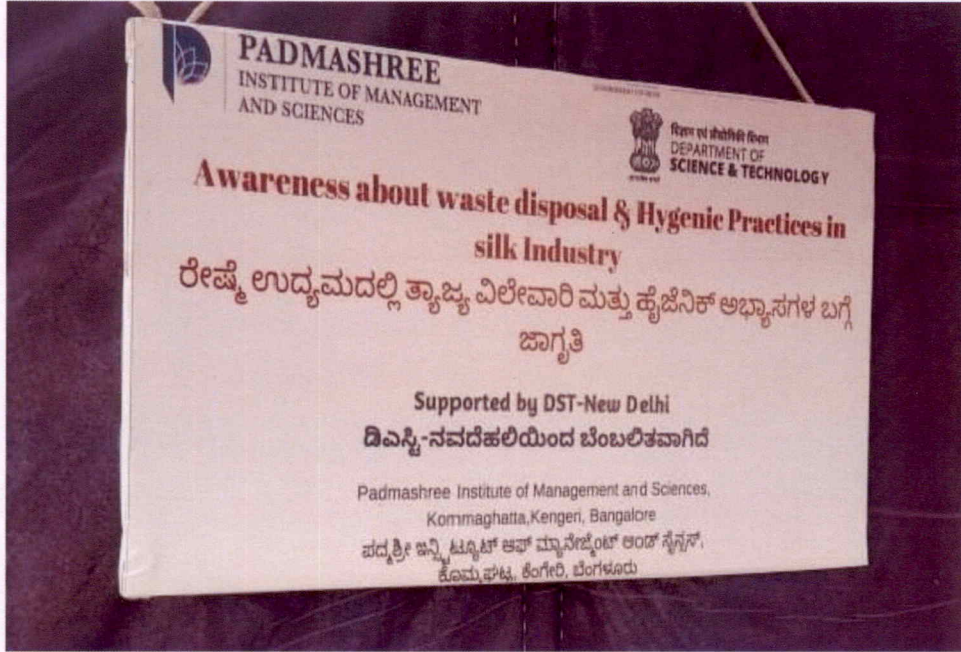



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Distribution of Arq e Ajeeb, Unani nasal drops to prevent Covid-19 infection

The program was organized by Sana Herbal Clinic and Padmashree Institute of Management and Sciences in Bangalore. It was aimed at distributing Arq e Ajeeb nasal drops to the public in Kottigepalya, Annaporneshwari Nagar and Sunkadkatte areas. The nasal drops were distributed by Dr. Muhib Jahan, a Faculty member in the Department of Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics, along with student volunteers. Arq e Ajeeb is beneficial for respiratory health as it helps soothe coughing, reduce tonsillitis and relieve chest congestion. It has anti-inflammatory properties and reduces swelling and pain. The presence of camphor in Arq e Ajeeb also helps kill bacteria, microbes and viruses. The distribution of the nasal drops was reported on daily news channels.

In addition to distributing the nasal drops, Dr. Muhib Jahan and the student volunteers also educated the public on how to use the drops effectively. They instructed the people on different methods to consume the drops, such as adding them to tea, coffee or warm water to improve immunity, and using it externally on the head and forehead to relieve headaches and sinusitis. The distribution was telecasted on a daily news channel and aimed to promote respiratory health and boost immunity.

Internally: Add 1-2 drops of liniment in 100 ml of water, Tea.

Steam inhalation: Add 4-5 drops in a bowl of hot boiling water and take steam for strengthening respiratory system.

Externally: Gently massage 2-4 drops of liniment on affected areas like in Joint pain, Muscular Pain, headache.




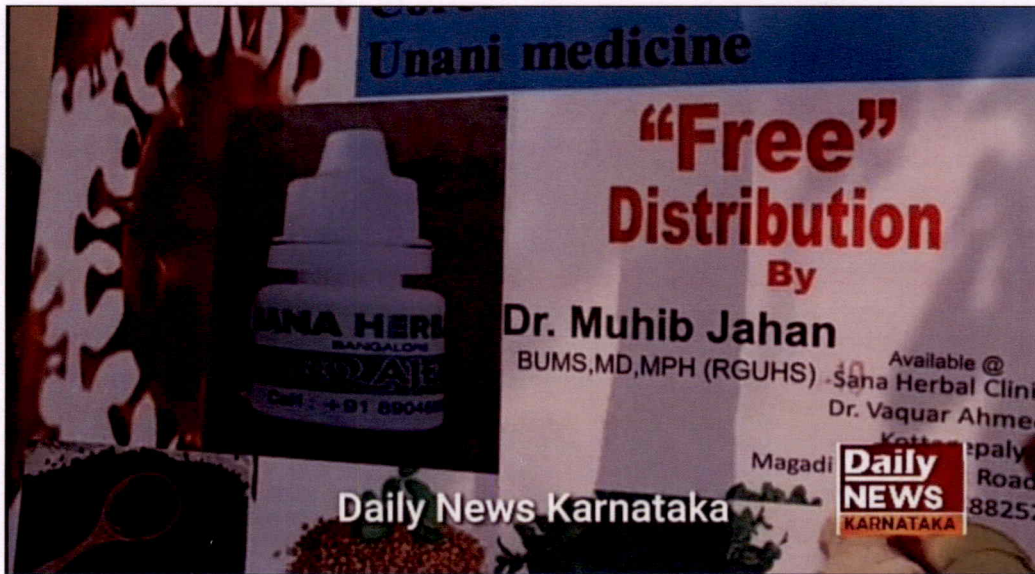

- The representative from administrative and non - teaching staff should encourage all administrative and non - teaching staff to take vaccination and collect the certificate from them after first dose and ensure that they take the second dose also.

- The benefits of getting vaccinated was discussed in the program by Dr Seema.


