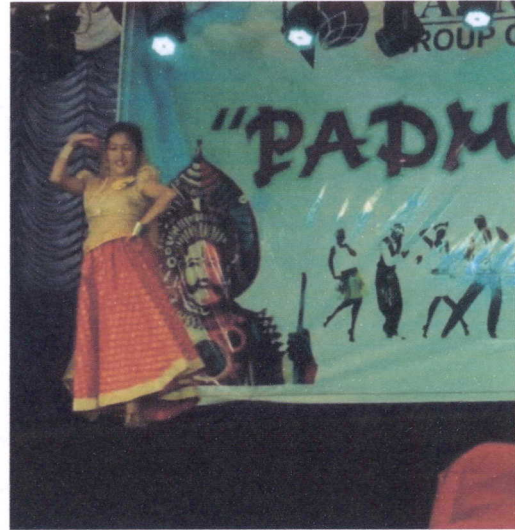
### Program summary:

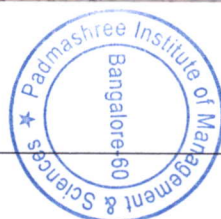
### **Program summary**


### Program summary


