




Program Summary

National Level Faculty Development Program (FDP) on "Strengthening Quality Research in Higher Education" was organized by Padmashree Institute of Management and Sciences from 19th to 24th July 2019 at PIMS in association with K – Tech Innovation Hub and Biotechnology Skill Enhancement Programme (BISEP), Bengaluru. The FDP started with twodays of expert talks from industry and academia. The program on 19th July was inaugurated by Dr. S.Shivakumara, Scientist, IBAB. He gave his insights on the research publication writing and publishing in the indexed journals of Scopus, web of science which adds on to the career advancement. Followed by Dr. Shivakumara, Dr. Savithri M Bhat, BMS College of Engineering, Bangalore spoke on the basics of writing research papers, different components of research papers and the importance of following the guidelines for writing a research articles. In the afternoon session Dr. Sathish Gowda, University Law College Bangalore University Bangalore gave his talk on significance of IPR in research, types of IPR and gave examples of some case studies related to Intellectual Property rights in case of any legal violations.

On 20th July Dr. Priyankana spoke about the various funding opportunities available to carry out research in academic institutions. The session was very interactive and queries regarding funding agencies and means to apply for funds were discussed. After this session, Dr. Anuradha, enlightened the participants about grant proposal writing and applying to various national funding agencies to secure grants. On both 19th and 20th participants were given opportunity to get Hands on experience through the activities planned to gain knowledge in searching patents, writing a research article template and so on. From 22nd to 24th July, Hands on Workshop was organized on Analytical Techniques, Molecular techniques and Nutritional Profiling from the faculties of PIMS. Faculty from various academic institutes of Karnataka, outside Karnataka participated in the FDP. The FDPwas contemplated to explore the basic dimensions of research, concomitant need for methodological issues in research publication, publication ethics, use and misuse of statistics in research, and availability of resources. This Faculty development program guided the participants to develop the skills to review literature, develop a hypothesis, frame research design, and comprehend the role and relevance of the tools for data collection and analysis. The hands on workshop helped the participants to learn about the basics of Chromatography techniques, Plant DNA isolation, Agarose gel electrophoresis and PCR. Through Proximate analysis of foods nutritional profiling was taught to the participants.





Case study methodology and facilitation skills in management education



- 1. 
